1. Always use quality alkaline D cells
2. Install new batteries with + terminals towards lens. Do not mix types.
3. Make sure cap is tightened as far as possible to engage O-ring
4. To switch beacon on, rotate lens clockwise; off, counter-clockwise
5. Stand beacon vertical in base on a firm surface, or use cone mount kit
6. Replace batteries when yellow LED indicator lights up



Aviation Base Mount

Secure mount for special purposes.



Cone Mount Clip

Attaches to any Eflare Beacon to enable vertical positioning of the beacon on most types of cones.



Magnetic Clip

Attaches to any Eflare Beacon.
Not suitable for moving vehicles.
