Goodman Fielder Lifts Safety

The huge Goodman Fielder food factory in Melbourne's western suburbs is now trialling Eflare safety beacons to help solve its safety problems.

The EF300 is being used for personal identification where a person in the factory can wear one via the lanyard around his neck. In badly lit areas and during night operation when safety is identified as an issue, the compact EF300 Red is switched on for the duration of the safety problem.

Additionally, the company is also trialling the TF510 Red (Torch Function) beacons. This powerful unit is being used to clearly mark an area where foot workers could be at risk from passing forklifts, at what the factory describes as an "...additional to normal activity.". Examples include warehouse operations where an area has to be marked out so stock taking can be done in safety as passing forklifts are given plenty of warning.

The Eflare LS510 safety beacon is a very innovative unit. It is fitted with a Light Sensitive (LS) photocell which works as being triggered at dusk and dawn and so automatically switching the beacon on and off. The benefits include the way the unit can be left for up to 7 days at a time before new batteries are needed.
